



Privacy Policy

This privacy policy (the “Policy”) describes how Global Cuisine Consulting, LLC (the “Company”) may collect, use, store and share personal information of consumer users of this website, www.globalcuisineconsulting.com (the “Site”). This Policy also applies to any of our other websites that post this Policy. However, this Policy does not apply to third-party websites that post differing statements. Our Policy applies to all forms of access to our site, including, but not limited to computer, mobile applications, external websites, or other forms of electronic devices. The company is committed to providing a safe consumer user experience and takes security breaches very seriously and shall promptly mitigate such infringements.

The terms used in our Policy should be read and understood in conjunction with our Terms of Use (the “Terms”). We encourage all consumer users to read our Policy which is a legally binding agreement, and by using our website, you consent and abide by our Terms and Policy.

POLICY UPDATES

The company may update its Policy from time to time and will post all modifications, revisions, and notices of such changes within a reasonable time. We reserve the right to change our Policy due to legal requirements or for business purposes. Consumer users will be notified of any changes through the “Last Updated” date posted at the end of this Policy unless other notice is required under applicable law.

DATA COLLECTION AND CHILDREN

Global Cuisine Consulting, LLC’s Site is intended for a general audience and the content is not directed toward children under the age of thirteen (13) years old. The company strictly abides by the Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act (“COPPA”) and does not knowingly collect personal information from children or minors. We request that if parents or internet service providers become aware or have reason to believe that any minor child has provided his or her

personal information without parental consent to please contact us immediately using the information in the “Contact Us” section.

INFORMATION COLLECTED

We may obtain information about you in a variety of ways.

Information You Give Us. Global Cuisine Consulting, LLC may collect personal information that is used to identify the consumer users of this Site. We may collect your full name, date of birth, personal or business address, email address, mobile or home telephone number, billing/payment information, as well as other information you directly provide us on our Site. The company may use the personal information provided to contact you and may also use the return email address to answer specific questions. All collected information will remain strictly confidential and be used primarily for business purposes. The company does collect any information pertaining to a consumer user’s religion, race, ethnicity, or political affiliation.

Information We Get From Others. We may get information about you from other websites or sources and such information may be added to our Site. However, the company does not license, lease or sell your personal information to third parties nor do we solicit any form of third-party advertising, marketing or promotional service. The company does not display any form of targeted or paid advertising on our Site. Your personal information will not be stored by our company Site unless you have subscribed to our email list or newsletter subscription.

Information Automatically Collected. We may automatically log information about you and your computer. For example, when visiting our Site, we may log your computer operating system type, browser type, browser language, the website you visited before browsing to our Site, IP address and domain, pages you viewed, how long you spent on a page, access times and information about your use of and actions on our Site. Also, your personal information may be disclosed to our third-party service providers that provide services to us including, but not limited to payment or credit card processing, shipping, and handling, information technology and infrastructure maintenance procedures. The company takes commercially reasonable measures to ensure that our service providers adhere to security protocols and professional standards however, we hold no legal liability for any third-party breaches of a customer user’s information, data or privacy.

Data Retention and Security. The company may retain your personal information in our database for business purposes as disclosed under our Policy, including for tax, legal, accounting, and other lawful purposes as may be deemed necessary.

Also, while we implement commercially reasonable measures to protect consumer users’ personal information from authorized use, access, fraud, misuse and disclosure, no internet transmission is fully secure, and you use this Site at your own risk. Please take special care prior to disclosing sensitive personal information to our company via the internet; we are not responsible for any circumvention of privacy and security measures due to internet breaches.

Cookies. We may log information using “cookies.” Cookies are small data files stored on your hard drive by a website. We may use both session Cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent Cookies (which stay on your computer until you delete them) to provide you with a more personal and interactive experience on our Site. This type of information is collected to make the Site more useful to you and to tailor the experience with us to meet your special interests and needs. You may remove and reject cookies from our Site using your browser settings. Many browsers are set to accept cookies until you change your settings. If you remove or reject our cookies, it could affect how our Site works for you and increase the lag time for Site performance.

USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We use your personal information as follows:

- We use your personal information to operate, maintain, and improve our sites, products, and services.
- We use your personal information to respond to comments, questions and to promptly provide customer service and feedback
- We use your personal information to send information including confirmations, invoices, technical notices, updates, security alerts, and support and administrative messages.
- We use your personal information to communicate about promotions, upcoming events, and other news about products and services offered by us and our selected partners.
- We use your personal information to link or combine user information with other personal information as defined specifically under our Terms.
- We use your personal information to protect, investigate, and deter against fraudulent, unauthorized, or illegal activity.
- We use your personal information to provide and deliver products, services and customer requests.

SHARING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may share personal information as follows:

- We may share personal information with your consent. For example, you may let us share personal information with others for their own marketing uses. Those uses will be subject to their privacy policies.
- We may share your personal information when we do a business deal, or negotiate a business deal, involving the sale or transfer of all or a part of our business or assets. These deals can include any merger, financing, acquisition, or bankruptcy transaction or proceeding.
- We may share personal information for legal, protection, and safety purposes.
- We may share information to comply with applicable laws, court order, subpoena or relevant requests by public authorities.

- We may share information to protect the rights and property of Global Cuisine Consulting, LLC, our agents, customers, and others. This includes enforcing our agreements, policies, and Terms of Use.
- We may share information in an emergency. This includes protecting the safety of our employees and agents, our customers, or any person.
- We may share information with those who need it to do work for us.
- We may also share aggregated and/or anonymized data with others for their own uses.

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (“GDPR”) POLICY
